

# How to create and communicate **your virtual nursing vision** to gain buy-in

## Understanding stakeholder priorities

- *How do priorities differ or align between departments and their leaders?*

Consider how the benefits of virtual nursing may address goals or pain points across your organization. Tactically, identify the key leaders from each department that will play a role in your transformation journey.

## Planning for success with expert advice

Nursing leaders who have already implemented virtual nursing programs understand the challenges that come on the transformation journey.

Top recommendations for success:

- 1 **Invest in change leadership** across your entire organization
- 2 **Ensure full executive leadership** support and buy-in
- 3 **Start small** with one nursing unit, capture feedback and iterate to scale efficiently
- 4 **Communicate** with other teams early and often, allowing for dialogue
- 5 **Involve staff** in all parts of the process
- 6 **Introduce your virtual nurse**, explaining how they will interact with the full care team
- 7 **Delineate tasks** that the virtual nurse will be responsible for
- 8 **Involve IT at the start** to weigh in on technology, network infrastructure, security and support needs
- 9 **Accommodate** the varying needs of patients in different units
